

# Arriving at Jersey City

**Disclaimer 1:** There are two Penn Stations. One in Newark and one in New York City. Please pay close attention to where you are going. If you are not sure please contact one of the POCs for help.

**Disclaimer 2:** For those traveling through/from Newark Airport, Newark Penn Station, or Secaucus Junction you should download and set up the NJ Transit app (links below) ahead of time to make traveling easier. (This should be done if you are planning on taking the bus and light rail in JC)

**Disclaimer 3:** If your arrival point is not listed here, do not hesitate to reach out for help.

## Grand Central Terminal

1. Walk to the MTA Subway station for the 7 Train and tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
2. Take the 7 Train heading towards 34 St-Hudson Yards for 2 stops to Times Sq-42 St

3. At Times Sq–42 St switch to either the R Train towards Bay Ridge-95 St, the N Train towards Coney Island-Stillwell Av, the Q Train towards Coney Island-Stillwell Av, or the W Train towards Whitehall St-South Ferry for 1 stop to 34 St-Herald Sq
4. Follow the signs for 33rd St PATH station and tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
5. Take the PATH train towards Journal Square (JSQ) to Grove Street (7 Stops)

## John F. Kennedy Airport (JFK)

### Option 1: Jamaica AirTrain

1. Follow signs for AirTrain station in Terminals 1, 4, 5, 7, or 8.
2. Take the Jamaica AirTrain to Jamaica Station (2 Stops, Last Stop). Pay AirTrain fare (\$8.75) as you exit the AirTrain station.
3. Walk over to the Sutphin Blvd Archer Av JFK Airport Station and tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
4. Take the E train heading towards World Trade Center for 20 stops to World Trade Center (It's the last stop)
5. Walk over to the World Trade Center PATH Station. It's inside the mall at the bottom floor. (<https://maps.app.goo.gl/EnDCHRp8JtkMoEGD7>)
6. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
7. Take the PATH heading towards Newark to Exchange Pl (1 Stop) or Grove Street (2 Stops)

### Option 2: Howard Beach AirTrain

1. Follow signs for AirTrain station in Terminals 1, 4, 5, 7, or 8.
2. Take the Howard Beach AirTrain to Howard Beach (3 Stops, Last Stop). Pay AirTrain fare (\$8.75) as you exit the AirTrain station.
3. Walk over to Howard Beach JFK Airport Station and tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
4. Take the A train heading towards Inwood-207 St for 24 stops to Chambers St
5. Walk over to the World Trade Center PATH Station. It's inside the mall at the bottom floor. (<https://maps.app.goo.gl/EnDCHRp8JtkMoEGD7>)
6. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
7. Take the PATH heading towards Newark to Exchange Pl (1 Stop) or Grove Street (2 Stops)

## LaGuardia Airport (LGA)

1. Take the Q70 Bus or Q33 Bus to Roosevelt Av/74 St (Tap to pay to get on, price is \$3.00)

2. Walk to the Jackson Hts-Roosevelt Av Subway Station and tap to pay to get in
  - Should be free if you used the same card for the bus
3. Take the F train heading towards Coney Island-Stillwell Av for 8 stops to 23rd St
4. Follow signs for the PATH station and tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
5. Take the PATH train towards Journal Square (JSQ) to Grove Street (6 Stops)

## Midtown / Port Authority Bus Terminal

1. Work your way down to the MTA subway system
2. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00) and follow signs for the R, N, Q, and W Train lines (yellow color).
3. Take either the R Train towards Bay Ridge-95 St, the N Train towards Coney Island-Stillwell Av, the Q Train towards Coney Island-Stillwell Av, or the W Train towards Whitehall St-South Ferry for 1 stop to 34 St-Herald Sq
4. Follow the signs for 33rd St PATH station.
5. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
6. Take the PATH train towards Journal Square (JSQ) to Grove Street (7 Stops)

## Newark Airport (EWR)

1. Use the NJ Transit app to buy a ticket from Newark Airport to Newark Penn Station (Price is \$12.30)
  - Activate the ticket and this will allow you to go through the Airtrain and on the train NJ Transit train
2. Take the Airtrain to the Newark Liberty International Airport Train Station

3. Walk over to the Newark Airport Train Station
4. Take the train heading to NYC for 1 stop to Newark Penn Station
  - If you miss your stop go to the Secaucus Junction or NYC Penn sections below
5. Walk towards the PATH section of the station
6. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
7. Take the PATH train towards WTC to Grove Street (3 Stops) or Exchange Pl (4 Stops)

## Newark Penn Station

1. Walk towards the PATH section of the station
2. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
3. Take the PATH train towards WTC to Grove Street (3 Stops) or Exchange Pl (4 Stops)

## NYC Penn Station / Moynihan Train Hall

1. Walk over to 33rd St PATH station.

2. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
3. Take the PATH train towards Journal Square (JSQ) to Grove Street (7 Stops)

## Secaucus Junction

### Option 1: Newark Penn Station

1. Use the NJ Transit app to buy a ticket from Secaucus Junction to Newark Penn Station (Price is \$4.95) and activate the ticket.
2. Work your way to Track B. You will need to scan your ticket to go through the gate.
3. Take either an NEC train towards Trenton or NJCL train towards Long Branch for 1 stop to Newark Penn Station
4. Walk towards the PATH section of the station
5. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
6. Take the PATH train towards WTC to Grove Street (3 Stops) or Exchange Pl (4 Stops)

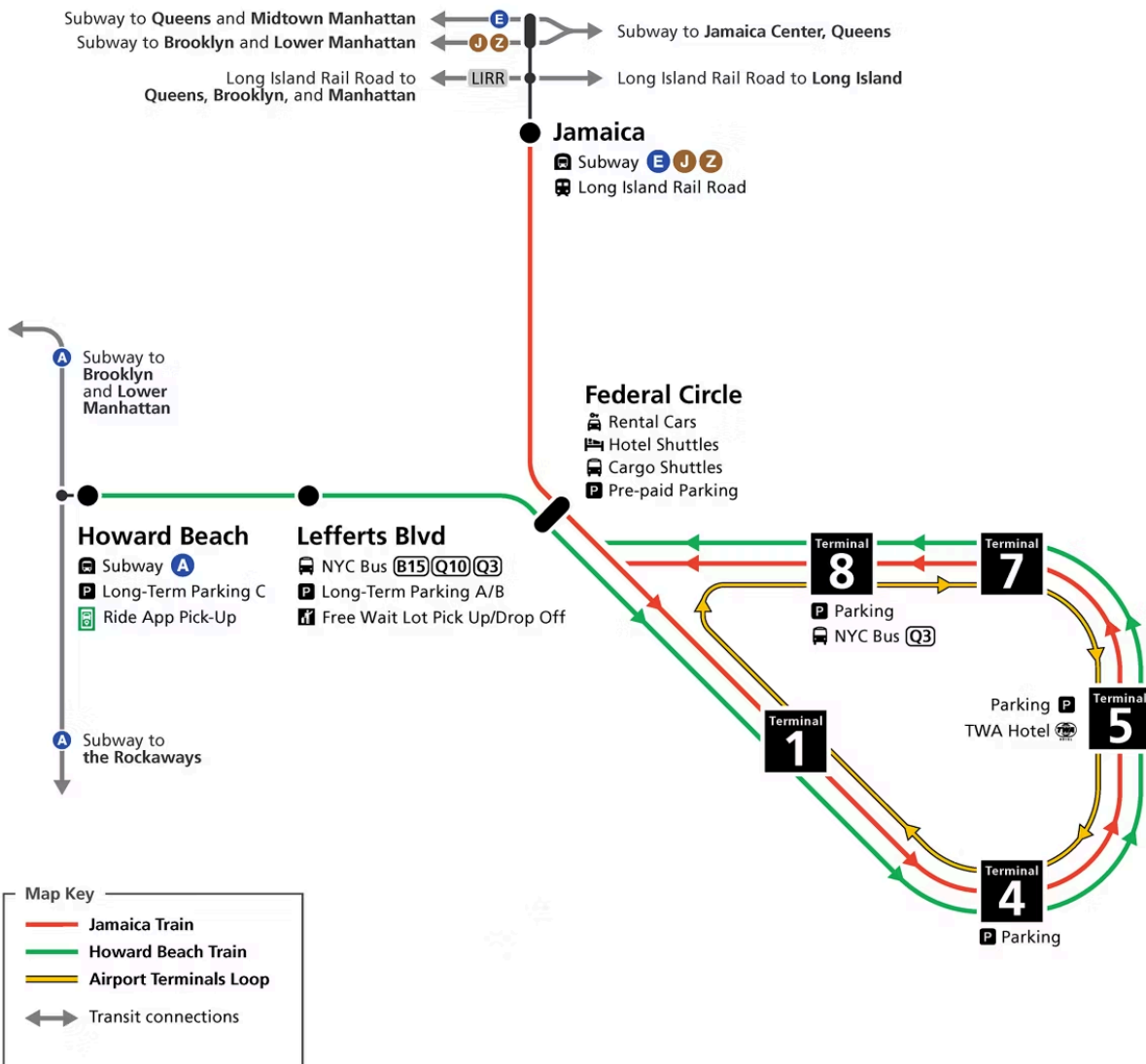
### Option 2: Hoboken Terminal

1. Use the NJ Transit app to buy a ticket from Secaucus Junction to Hoboken (Price is \$3.55) and activate the ticket.
2. Work your way to either Track E, Track G, or Track H. You will need to scan your ticket to go through the gate.
3. Take either an MAIN train on Track E, BERG train on Track G, or PASC train on Track H towards Hoboken for 1 stop
4. At Hoboken Terminal follow signs for the PATH Station. (If you are looking at the terminal lobby or NYC skyline it will be to the left.)
5. Tap to pay to get in (Price is \$3.00)
6. Take the PATH train towards Journal Square (JSQ) to Grove Street (2 Stops)

### **Cost and Tickets**

The AirTrain is free within the airport – between airline terminals, parking lots, hotel shuttles and rental car facilities.

Without a NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak ticket, the cost to access AirTrain is \$8.75 when entering and exiting Newark Liberty International Airport Train Station. More information can be found in the [next section](#).

If you take PATH, New York City Transit Subways, or the Long Island Rail Road, you will pay a separate fare for those services. Visit their websites for more information.

### **NJ TRANSIT and Amtrak Tickets**

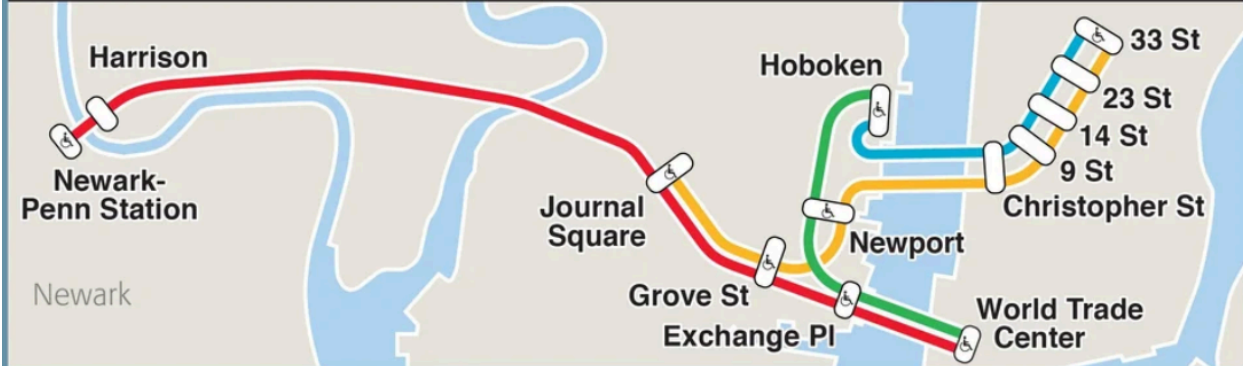
When you buy a NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak ticket to/from Newark Liberty International Airport Train Station, that one ticket includes the AirTrain Newark portion, which is \$8.75. The AirTrain access fee is not charged for children (11 and under) or for customers using monthly passes with the airport as the origin or destination.

You must use your ticket twice regardless of which direction you're traveling. You'll need to show the ticket to the conductor on the NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak train, and you'll need the ticket to pass through the fare line at Newark Liberty International Airport (RailLink) Station. Be sure to take the ticket with you.

Contact PATH, NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak for more information on fares, discounted monthly tickets, ten-trip tickets and other special fares. All fares are subject to change.
